



Safeguarding Children Level 3

Course Content

Level 3 safeguarding Children training will enable you to identify, assess and meet the needs of children where there is a Safeguarding need. It will support you to engage with interagency working and share information effectively. It will provide you with an understanding of interagency systems and processes and provide you with practice tools which can support you with professional judgement. The Training will enhance your recognition of Child Abuse and Neglect by exploring factors which may be evident in the child's and parent's life as well as in their environment.

Target Audience

All clinical staff working with children, young people and/or their parents/carers and/or any adult who could pose a risk to children and could potentially contribute to assessing, planning, intervening and/or evaluating the needs of a child or young person and/or parenting capacity (regardless of whether there have been previously identified child protection/safeguarding concerns or not).
