

Neonatal Life Support (NLS) - Level 2

Course Content:

These sessions cover the syllabus outlined in the Skills for Health Framework.

- Know how to recognise and respond to a newborn child
- Understand the importance of temperature control in the care of the newborn
- Be able to provide basic airway management
- Be able to initiate and maintain effective lung ventilations
- Be able to initiate and maintain effective chest compressions

Audience:

Staff that have direct clinical care responsibilities. Staff are expected to have level two in the patient group for which they have responsibility for.

For example: staff that only have responsibility for paediatric patients are only required to have level 2 paediatric basic life support.

Course Delivery:

Neonatal Life Support (level 2) is a 1 hour blended learning session. Along with attendance to the 1 hour practical learning session you must complete the '**000 Resuscitation Newborn Level 2**' e-learning module on ESR or complete the workbook in order to achieve compliance with your mandatory training.
