

# Paediatric Immediate Life Support (epILS)

## **Course Content:**

This is a Resuscitation Council (UK) course aimed at registered healthcare professionals who are working with children.

The course teaches the necessary skills that are required to recognise deterioration and manage the first few minutes of a respiratory / cardiac arrest whilst awaiting the arrival of the team. This course blends e-learning with face to face skills training.

## **Audience:**

Registered healthcare professionals who would be expected to participate as part of the resuscitation team.

## **Course Delivery:**

Blended learning session: e-learning and face to face skills training.

## **Prerequisites:**

RC(UK) regulations state that candidates must have access to the course material at least 2 weeks before the course. This includes the **4<sup>th</sup> edition** PILS manual and given access to the e-PILS web app.

You can access the course on your mobile, tablet or PC. **It is advisable to log in early to ensure you can access the site.** You will receive an email from the Resuscitation Council advising you to log in to the LMS system, alternatively go to [Resuscitation Council UK: Log in to the site](#)

Course material may be collected from the ward/department manager or from training and development. If a member of staff already has a **4<sup>th</sup> edition** PILS manual they are not required to collect a new manual but they must confirm that they are in possession of an up to date copy.

Confirmation of having an up to date manual AND the pre course MCQ which is on ESR must be completed prior to being booked onto a course date.

On the day of the course managers may only send a substitute in place of staff booked for pILS or ILS if the above criteria has been met by the person attending.

Due to strict RCUK regulations 100% attendance is required to successfully complete the pILS or ILS course. Late attendees will be requested to re-book with training.
